



Some Secrets of the ABC Players Web Site

Everybody knows that you can go to the ABC Players Web site (<u>www.abcplayers.org</u>) to see a list of shows for the current season, current officers, upcoming auditions, photos from completed shows, information about the next meeting, the history of the organization, and copies of both *The Minotaur* and *The AACT Spotlight*, but here are some lesser-known useful (or fun) features:

Keep Current: To learn the most recent change to the site's content, click the "What's New" link in the Features menu. To find out all of the changes since the last time you checked, click the "What's New" link and then click the "Details" button. Every time there's a change in content, that change is described in What's New and added to the Details list.

Donate On-Line: Click the "Donate" link in the Features menu.

Read New York Theater Reviews: Click the "Toys" link in the Features menu, and then click the link labeled "The Latest Theater News from New York." Here, you'll find current play reviews from *The New York Times* and *The Village Voice*.

Learn How Unimportant Correct Spelling Is to Good Communication: Click the "Toys" link in the Features menu, and then click the link labeled "A Demonstration of the Marginal Utility of Correct Spelling."

Curse in Elizabethan English: Click the "Toys" link in the Features menu, and then click the link labeled "A Generator of Elizabethan Curses." Follow the directions to obtain as many curses as you need.

Help Keep the Code "Pure": Click the button at the bottom of each page labeled "W3C XHTML 1.0." This will cause the code on the page to be validated by the World Wide Web Consortium, which sets the standards for everything having to do with the World Wide Web. If you don't see a page that declares, "This document was successfully checked as XHTML 1.0 Strict!" please send an e-mail to the.abc.players@gmail.com telling which page didn't validate so it can be fixed.
